Set on 250 acres, Troutbeck was once a gathering place for poets and philosophers and is now a Hudson Valley estate with guest rooms, restaurants, wellness facilities and year-round cultural programming. Stay options range from manor house rooms with wood floors and

working fireplaces to farmhouse-style suites and private cottages. This fall, Troutbeck is offering special incentives for midweek stays: Guests can enjoy discounted room rates and wellness credits — a welcome perk after days spent hiking fiery woodlands, casting for trout in the Webatuck River or cycling the Harlem Valley Rail Trail.

Evenings center on fireside meals built around Hudson Valley produce, while wellness takes shape at The Barns — a light-filled complex with studios, saunas and treatment rooms. Guests can also opt for equestrian outings or private falconry sessions, while the creative programming brings in artist residencies, literary talks and workshops. No car? No problem.
