

**TROUTBECK'S  
GUIDE TO  
MILLBROOK  
NY**

Though “Millbrook,” has often become synonymous with the surrounding areas (such as the Shekomeko and Smithfield Valleys, Stanfordville, and Pine Plains), the village of Millbrook itself is small and quaint. If you’re driving to Troutbeck from New York City and take the Taconic State Parkway, then you will pass right through (or skirt just past) the village of Millbrook. If it’s a gorgeous day and you’ve got time before check in, make a point of stopping at **INNISFREE**, the exquisitely maintained hundred year old Asian-inspired garden just off of Route 44.

In town, though the wonderfully maintained classic diner is tempting from a retro aesthetic perspective, the best breakfast in Millbrook is right next door to it: an excellent cappuccino and croissant at **CANOE HILL**, where one can also choose from a cleverly curated selection of scented candles, kitchen accessories and natural wine. If you find yourself hungry for lunch, **BABETTE'S KITCHEN** is the right place to get it (we recommend a B.L.T. and an Arnold Palmer, but their prepared foods are all worthy). From Memorial Day weekend through October 1st, Millbrook hosts a Saturday farmer’s market, with gorgeous fruit and veg from local farms, while just south of town on Route 82, **LOCUST HILL MARKET** offers grass fed meat raised on the premises as well as seasonal veg and specialty products. For dinner in town, the best option is **CAFÉ LES BAUX**, a traditional French bistro that serves classics such as salade frisée lardons, moules marinières and steak frîtes. **BARBARO**, on Franklin Street, has wood-fired Neapolitan pizzas and approachable Italian fare.

Millbrook is known for its horse people and its antique shops, so wander up the main drag (Franklin Street), from the **MILLBROOK ANTIQUE MALL** to the **MILLBROOK ANTIQUE CENTER**, which has a slightly fancier selection, passing Juniper, a gift shop and children’s store, along the way. Also on Franklin Avenue are **ALICIA ADAMS ALPACA**, where you can find everything from a hot water bottle cozy to a luxurious wrap all handmade out of alpaca.

Off the main drag is the **MERRITT BOOKSHOP**, an excellent book and gift shop for all ages. As you drive out of town, north on 44, back toward Troutbeck, you’ll pass **CREEL & GOW**, owned by lauded interior designer Jamie Creel, where you can find irresistible and expensive home accessories and antiques, or a gorgeous topiary at the adjacent **ORANGERIE**.

About halfway between the village of Millbrook and Amenia, where Troutbeck is located, you can turn off route 44 onto Bangall Amenia Road and visit the **TREVOR ZOO** at the Millbrook School, where red pandas, lemurs, river otters, snakes, coyotes, birds of prey and more are cared for by the students.
