

TROUTBECK'S GUIDE TO MILLERTON NY

Located 15-minutes by car and 45-minutes by bike from Troutbeck, Millerton is an historical town in Dutchess County that is bordered by the Taconic Mountains to the east and the foothills of the Hudson to the west. The village's Main Street still reflects its origins as a 19th century railroad hub for rural New York, while offering a cosmopolitan selection of independently owned businesses like a movie house, a retro diner, antique shops, and more. In the late spring, summer, and fall, our favorite way to get to Millerton is via the **HARLEM VALLEY RAIL TRAIL** on bicycle. The scenic bike and walking trail bisects the village and is part of the Hudson River Valley Greenway.

The key to exploring Millerton is to park your car or bike either at the west end (near **HARNEY & SONS FINE TEAS**, where their tasting bar and lounge offers 250 varieties of the highest quality, hand-picked, full-leaf teas) or the east end (near **IRVING FARM NEW YORK**, a welcoming hub serving coffee, artisanal teas & light fare including soups, sandwiches & pastries). From there you can explore the collection of antique stores and boutiques by strolling one side of Main Street until you reach its end, crossing the road to its other side, and then looping back to your original starting point. Please note that the Main Street is neither flat nor straight. Instead it winds through the village on an incline from west to east.

Millerton is famous for its antique stores, where treasures range from old fashioned postcards to 18th century furniture, vintage clothing, and more. **HUNTER BEE** is an antique store with a unique perspective ranging from American country and industrial pieces to mid-century design classics. **MONTAGE ANTIQUES** is a beautifully curated boutique where you will always find a vast array of furniture, lighting, art, and other attractive things for your home. For contemporary home goods and clothing, we recommend **WESTERLIND**, an outdoor apparel and gear boutique featuring the best brands from around the globe. An icon of the town is **OBLONG BOOKS**. Founded in 1975, they are the largest independent bookseller in the Hudson Valley, as well as have a fun collection of children's toys, games, and puzzles. For dining, we like to keep it relaxed and casual at the imaginative, bright, and retro-styled **OAKHURST DINER** that servers all day diner classics with a twist.

If you are looking to immerse yourself in the bucolic scenery and farms of the surrounding areas, we suggest three interesting and different adventures. For the foodie, there is **KINGS HIGHWAY CIDER SHACK**. The East Coast's award-winning cidery set up shop at the North East's largest organic farm, **MCENROE ORGANIC FARM**, a few years ago and they have a full-service restaurant that serves burgers, lobster rolls, bratwurst, chicken tacos, and a whole lot more. For the aesthete, there is **THE RE INSTITUTE**, which is an exhibition space situated in the hay loft of a 1960's barn that is part of a forty-acre working farm. The Re Institute hosts an annual series of small group shows, bringing together visual artists, filmmakers, writers, composers, dancers, and outdoor installation artists. Finally, for the adventure, we suggest a sunset ride with **MOUNTAIN VALLEY FARM**. The unique horse farm provides western horseback riding and skeet shooting, and has access to more than 4,000 acres of trails with sweeping vistas along the Hudson Valley in the West & the Berkshires to the East.
